THE FREEDOM CONFERENCE

After winning a program-record five Skyline Conference Championships during the 2006-07 academic year, the Manhattanville Valiants left the league behind and joined the powerful Middle Atlantic States Collegiate Athletic Corporation and the Freedom Conference June 1, 2007.

One of the oldest athletic conferences in the nation, the MASCAC encompasses the Freedom, Commonwealth and Middle Atlantic conferences and has produced six national champions in the past three seasons. The Valiants join Wilkes, King's, Arcadia, Delaware Valley, DeSales and FDU-Florham to comprise the 2007-08 Freedom Conference.
